Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we head into the month of May, warmer weather is upon us, and the planting season is going full force. School is finishing another academic year and with that graduations will be taking place. It is also the month when we honor high school graduates, celebrate another year of Sunday School, observe Mother's Day and Memorial Day. In the month of May we are bringing to conclusion the Great 50 Day Easter celebration with the Festival of Pentecost and the Rite of Confirmation (May 23rd), and on the following Sunday is the Festival of the Holy Trinity (May 30th). May looks jammed packed here at Church. I hope, even with your busy schedules, to carve out that time on Sunday mornings for worship. Worship the most important activity that takes place here at Bethany. When you are absent from the fellowship of believers, we are less that what we can be. The church is stronger and more complete when you are present.

Pentecost is the Celebration of the Holy Spirit. Fifty days after the resurrection of Jesus Christ a rush of a mighty wind filled the room where the Apostles were gathered. Tongues of fire also settled on their heads and they began to speak in tongues proclaiming the mighty acts of God to all foreign visitors using their native languages. They all heard the Good News of God in Christ Jesus plainly from these men who had never spoken in a foreign tongue before. Before it was all over 3,000 were baptized that day and the Church was born. So, in a way Pentecost is the birthday celebration of the Church. I believe I read somewhere that in the great Festivals of the Church Year, Pentecost would be the third slightly behind Epiphany at number two and of course Easter, what many would consider the number one festival. But if you think about it, every Sunday a celebration the resurrection of Jesus Christ, thus making the rest of the Sundays "Little Easters."

But that is beside the point. Pentecost is always a reminder that we would not even have the gift of faith in Jesus if it were not for the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives. I believe that I cannot come to faith in Jesus Christ through my own strength or reason, but it the Holy Spirit calls, enlightens me through the gospel brings me to faith, and in the same way calls, gathers and enlightens the Christian Church and keep it in the one true faith (from Martin Luther's Small Catechism, paraphrased). I know the day does not lend itself to the sweet memories of Christmas or the triumph of Easter. If anything, it might convey a sense of longing and incompleteness. It may well be a great time for us to acknowledge our fears and anxiousness in this day and time in church life, and longing for what we can be as congregation on fire for Christ. It happened 2,000 years ago with 12 apostles gathered in an upper room waiting for the promised power from on high. And when it came the world was changed. I pray it can happen here.
